COVID-19

- On March 24, 2020, 34 patients were tested for COVID-19 at one of Concord Hospital Medical Group's two dedicated COVID-19 screening/testing sites and 13 of those patients were further evaluated by a provider. Since March 16, 336 patients have been screened at the two sites.
- Concord Hospital Medical Group (CHMG) practices have suspended regular office visits and instead are conducting telemedicine/remote visits. On March 24, 2020, CHMG provided 443 TeleHealth visits and two VideoHealth visits. Since March 17, 2020, 1,939 TeleHealth or VideoHealth visits have been provided.
- As of March 25, 2020, the Concord Hospital health system has ordered COVID-19 tests for approximately 419 patients. To date, the Hospital has received results for 179 patients, which includes five COVID-19 positive results.
- Of the five positive results, one patient is currently hospitalized at Concord Hospital and four are recovering at home.
- Concord Hospital is working on establishing a COVID-19 screening and education phone line for the public. More information to come.

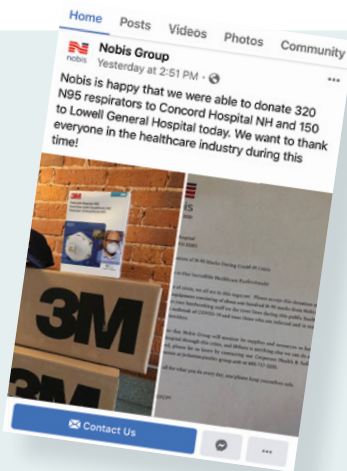
OUR WISH LIST
